Q: What are the types of applications that may be able to help my community make better informed decisions?

A: Common applications for communities may include, *but are not limited to*:

- All departments – Understanding and viewing spatial relationships to department-specific data in relation to assessor's parcel data and aerial imagery
- Assessor's – Managing parcel data to perform pre-defined or custom tasks such as generating abutter's lists or printing area maps
- Assessor's – Site viewing/analysis with current aerial imagery
- Building – Permit tracking and site viewing/analysis
- DPW – Reviewing and updating accuracy of road data in relation to Ch. 90 funding
- DPW – Asset management
- Fire – Hydrant Mapping and project Pre-Planning
- Planning – Access to dozens of data sets essential to the planning process such as zoning, land use and open space data, areas of environmental resources or sensitivity, demographic and socio-economic data or elevation/topography
- Police – Crime Mapping and project Pre-Planning
- Public Safety/Emergency Management – Access to current, accurate address and Critical Infrastructure data
